Clonmacnoise – Connemara

Total driving distance & time: 310 km - 4 hours 10 minutes

Switch on Paddy the Pocket Pilot app and start your self-drive tour crafted by expert local trip planners. Leave Dublin behind for Clonmacnoise, a beautiful 6th-century monastery on the banks of the River Shannon. This remarkable place was a center of excellence for learning and saw scholars create some of the finest Celtic art and manuscripts for over 600 years.

With a whetted appetite, you will cross the country into County Galway. Your next stop is Kylemore Abbey in the heart of Connemara. The rugged landscape of Connemara come hail rain or shine is guaranteed to take your breath away. Spend time roaming the abbey and Victorian walled garden on this 1000-acre estate overlooking Kylemore Lake and the majestic Connemara National Park.

At the end of a busy day, stay in Clifden surrounded by the Twelve Bens mountain range. Discover some great bars, restaurants, and nightly music, and have a chat with the locals over a pint of the Black Stuff!

Day Two

The Aran Islands

Total driving distance & time: 100 km – 1 hour 40 minutes

A short drive brings you to Rossaveal Pier on Galway Bay. Here, you board the ferry to the Aran Islands. You'll land on the largest of the three islands: Inishmore. Explore this rugged island by bicycle or by special request jaunting cart.

The route will take Dún Aonghasa, a stone fort that lies 100m over the ocean, before circling back to the mainland. While on Inishmore, you might pick up a few words of "Gaeilge" from the locals. And why not treat yourself to an authentic Aran Sweater?

Your departure from Rossaveal is the start of our Galway adventure. Hug the coastline into bustling, bohemian Galway. Expect a great atmosphere, entertaining street performers and plenty of craic in this much-celebrated town.

Galway – The Cliffs Of Moher

Total driving distance & time: 90 km - 1 hour 45 minutes

Galway is a city that has its Medieval history at its very heart. Our local guide will take you down the narrow streets where you can duck in and out of brightly coloured shops.

Try on Claddagh Rings and Galway Shawls and pass through The Spanish Arch to take in the famous Claddagh fishing village.

This day just keeps on giving. You will now travel south west towards The Burren National Park and the jaw-dropping Cliffs of Moher. On this adventure, you will visit Corcomroe Abbey, a 13th century Cistercian Monstary and the 16th century Dunguaire Castle in Kinvara.

The cliffs experience will take you by foot across its stunning natural features with the powerful Atlantic Ocean waves crashing in below. The cliffs are one of the most spectacular natural features in Ireland and are sure to leave you lost for words. The evening is spent in the hometown of traditional Irish music - Doolin.







Doolin To Dingle

Total driving distance & time: 240 km - 3 hours 30 minutes

A trip to Ireland is not complete without seeing all the ancient structures. Drive to the most famous Dolmen at Poulnabrone. These Neolithic monuments are scattered throughout the country marking burial sites and passageways dating back to 3000 BC.

A short journey from the Dolmen, the farmers at Caherconnell will treat you to a spectacular sheepdog trial. Prepared to be awestruck by the skill of the farmer and his furry friend as they gather up their flock of sheep. Cross the border by ferry to County Kerry and leave the west behind. It is time to get excited about your next destination - Dingle.

The evening in Dingle is yours to absorb the town's renowned atmosphere, from its famous quirky pubs to the restaurants serving mouthwatering dishes. Why not sit in Foxy John's hardware store, order yourself a drink, and strike up a conversation with a friendly local? Rest your head at your fantastic guesthouse handpicked by our team.

Day Five

The Dingle Peninsula

Total driving distance & time: 50 km - 2 hours 30 minutes

Today your morning begins out on Dingle Bay where you will explore caves and inlets by kayak. And if kayaking isn't your thing, you can enjoy a pleasurable hike up Eask Tower. At the top, you will be rewarded with breathtaking panoramic views of Dingle Bay.

If you just want to stroll around Dingle itself, exploring the colorful buildings, cute craft shops, and cafes, go ahead and enjoy yourself! This is your holiday - Do it your way.

In the afternoon, return to your car and take a trip along The Slea Head Drive, one of Ireland's most scenic and impressive roads. You spend another night in the buzzing town of Dingle, so you're free to relax and enjoy however you please.

Sites On The Ring Of Kerry

Total driving distance & time: 200 km - 3 hours 30 minutes

Say your fond farewells to Dingle and journey towards the Ring of Kerry. The first stop takes you to Killarney. The Ring of Kerry is the very definition of the word scenic and you will discover many hidden gems including Moll's Gap, Torc Waterfall and Ross Castle in Killarney National Park. We will arrange a guided tour of Ross Castle where you will learn what life was really like behind the stone walls.

Stop for some shopping and lunch in the beautiful heritage town of Kenmare. For your last night on tour, we are excited to send you to coastal Kinsale which is famed for its culinary culture, delivered by its many award-winning restaurants.

The town also has a wonderful tradition for poetry, as well as gold, silver, and glassware manufacturing. You can see the fruits of these throughout Kinsale's local shops and galleries that boast the works of local talented artists.





Cork – Kiss The Blarney Stone

Total driving distance & time: 320 km - 3 hours 30 minutes

Wake up refreshed and ready to be taken on a guided walking tour through the narrow streets of Kinsale with one of Ireland's greatest guides, Barry.

Your self-drive App Paddy will lead you on to Blarney because you simply cannot leave Cork without visiting Blarney Castle and Gardens and giving the Blarney Stone a big fat kiss!

Your final stop before driving back to Dublin is the Rock of Cashel. The Rock of Cashel is over 1000 years old and you will get to see its medieval round tower, chapel, cathedral, and castle. A fantastic end to your trip.
