

Glendalough – Cork

Total driving distance & time: 330 kilometres – 4 hours 10 minutes

Turn on your Paddy the Pocket Pilot App and hit the road! Glendalough in the Wicklow Mountains, perched centrally in Ireland's Ancient East, is the first stop after leaving the hustle and bustle of Dublin behind.

You will take a guided tour of an important monastic site, learn about Ireland's history and folklore, and take in the impressive St. Kevin's Round Tower, built back in the 6th century.

After this introduction to Irish history, it's time to travel south, where the Rock of Cashel awaits. Prepare to take plenty of jealousy-inducing photos at this famous medieval landmark.

In the afternoon and evening, you will make yourself at home in the luxurious Hayfield Manor in Cork City. You will have an endless choice of places to eat and be entertained this evening or simply relax and enjoy the lavish surroundings of the manor house.

Blarney – Killarney

Total driving distance & time: 140 km - 2 hours 10 minutes

You simply cannot visit Ireland without a trip to Blarney Castle and Gardens. Kissing the Blarney Stone (and receiving the gift of the gab... hopefully!) is an absolute must. Take the time to roam and admire the beautiful gardens surrounding the castle.

Then it's off to Kenmare, nestled between the Ring of Kerry and the Beara Peninsula, where you will enjoy lunch.

Killarney, the Capital of Kerry, is your next destination. Here, you will marvel at the spectacular views at Moll's Gap, Ladies View, and Torc Waterfall before exploring the natural wonderland of Killarney National Park. In the afternoon you will enjoy a jaunt - riding in a horse-pulled carriage. And if you have the energy, you can cycle around this stunning 100km estate, taking in Muckross House, Ross Castle, and much more.

The evening is yours to spend wandering around Killarney's wonderful shops, pubs, and eateries. You will stay at the magnificent four-star Lake Hotel where you will receive a traditional Irish welcome with stunning surroundings. Total driving distance & time: 179 km - 4 hours

After your invigorating cliffs experience, you deserve to unwind! Live like royalty in the celebrated, 5-star Dromoland Castle.













Day Five

Bunratty – Galway

Total driving distance & time: 72 km – 1 hour

This morning, you can either take your time to enjoy the activities and estate at Dromoland or make the short drive to Bunratty Castle where you can join a folk and heritage tour.

As you depart County Clare, your bustling, bohemian Galway adventure begins. Voted European Capital of Culture 2020, this city will not disappoint. Total driving distance & time: 110 km - 1 hour 50 minutes

While you're here, enjoy some time roaming the abbey, in the Victorian walled garden, and near Kylemore Lake. Soak up the splendor of this 1000-acre estate overlooking the majestic Connemara National Park.

Ballynahinch Castle awaits you. Let them serve up a sumptuous afternoon tea in one of their luxurious rooms. Once you park up at this hidden gem, you will not want to leave.





Westport - Ashford Castle


Total driving distance & time: 120 kilometres - 2 hours

This morning you will challenge yourself to a hike up Ireland's holiest mountain - Croagh Patrick. It was made famous by St. Patrick himself. At the top, you will be treated to panoramic views of Clew Bay.

If hiking is not your thing, why not grab a bike and cycle along the Greenway route to Achill Island or have a relaxed walking tour of Westport Town?
