Clonmacnoise – Croagh Patrick, Westport

Total driving distance & time: 300 km – 3 hours 50 minutes

This expertly planned self-drive tour will leave Dublin for the beauty and surroundings of Clonmacnoise, a 6th-century monastery on the banks of the River Shannon. Clonmacnoise was a center of excellence for learning – for over 600 years scholars created the finest Celtic art and illuminated manuscripts.

All you have to do is jump in the car, start up your App, and let Paddy the Pocket Pilot guide you around the enchanting Emerald Isle.

Onwards towards Ireland's favorite town - Westport in County Mayo. After fueling up, we will send you to the base of Croagh Patrick - Ireland's holiest mountain made famous by the man responsible for St. Patrick's Day celebrations around the world. You will take a moderate hike up the mountain and be treated to outstanding views over Clew Bay.

We guarantee you will be full of energy and ready for a great evening of fun in Westport town. Be sure to catch a traditional music session in the famous "Matt Molloy's Pub". Local musicians gather nightly to entertain the masses.





Day Two

Achill Island – Clifden, Connemara

Total driving distance & time: 125 km – 2 hours 10 minutes

Achill Island awaits you this morning. Take the Greenway cycle route from Mulranny to Achill Island or you have the option to drive to Slievemore and enjoy a leisurely hike on the Island. It's your holiday so enjoy it at your own pace.

After enjoying the morning on Ireland's largest island, you will make your way back towards Connemara through the stunning Inagh Valley and Famine Trail. Tonight, you will stay in Clifden which is nestled at the base of the Twelve Bens mountain range. Clifden boasts some very fine eateries and watering holes where you can strike up a conversation with some interesting locals, often willing to tell a tall tale or two!

You have the option of staying in a stunning castle overnight. Why not add a bit of luxury to your trip of a lifetime and embrace your inner Prince(ss)?

Kylemore Abbey – Connemara National Park

Total driving distance & time: 100 km – 1 hour 50 minute

Begin your Galway experience in the heart of Connemara with a tour of the beautiful Kylemore Abbey. Come rain, shine, or even hail, the rugged landscape of Connemara will take your breath away. Enjoy roaming the abbey and the wonderful Victorian walled garden on this 1000-acre estate that overlooks the serene Kylemore Lake and the surrounding, majestic Connemara National Park.

From here you can choose three different hike levels - The Diamond Hill offers two fantastic loop walks from 1.5 hours to 3 hours depending on your energy levels or pace. Alternatively, why not go big and trek across the Twelve Bens Mountain range? The Bens will take between 4-6 hours.

After giving yourself a wonderful workout make the drive to the City of the Tribes - Galway. Here every night is said to be a Friday night. You will have a wonderful evening soaking up the lively atmosphere of the bustling medieval city. We have carefully handpicked a centrally located accommodation so that you are within a stone's throw of the "craic" (fun) and all the local hotspots. Ask Paddy the Pocket Pilot for some recommendations.



Aran Islands – Galway

Total driving distance & time: 80 km – 1 hour 20 minutes

After a short drive to Rossaveal Pier, you will take a ferry across Galway Bay to the Aran Islands. Landing on Inishmore; rugged, spectacular, and the largest of the three Aran Islands, it's time to explore this isolated wonder. You can either cycle or make a special request for a jaunting cart.

Follow the route toward the ancient stone fort of Dún Aonghasa. This breathtaking site stands on a cliff edge 100m above the wild Atlantic below. While you are here, try to pick up some "Gaeilge" from the locals or buy an original Aran Sweater!

When you return to the mainland, there's no need to pack your bags as you will spend another exciting evening in the European Culture Capital -Galway. You can even practice your new Irish words with the locals! We guarantee they will be impressed.





Day Five

The Cliffs Of Moher

Total driving distance & time: 75 km – 1 hour 30 minutes

Medieval history is at the heart of Galway, and now that you have a "feel" for the city, it's time to follow our guide down the narrow, charming streets while ducking in and out of brightly colored shops. Try on Galway Shawls and Claddagh Rings before passing through The Spanish Arch toward the famous fishing village of Claddagh.

This incredible day has plenty more in store yet! Leaving Galway, you travel southwest towards the otherworldly Burren National Park and the Irish icon that is the Cliffs of Moher. Along the way, you will stop at Corcomroe Abbey, a Cistercian Monastery dating back to the 13th century, and the 16th-century Dunguaire Castle, located in the fishing village of Kinvara.

The Cliffs of Moher experience takes you on a walk across this stunning natural feature as the powerful Atlantic Ocean waves crashing in below. This is truly one of the most jaw-dropping places in Ireland and we're sure you'll be lost for words!

You will then spend the evening in Doolin. This isn't just a welcoming and colourful village, it's also the home of traditional Irish music!

Day Six

The Burren National Park – Dublin

Total driving distance & time: 265 km – 3 hours 10 minutes

From the village of Doolin, we will arrange for you to pick up bicycles so you can head off and explore Burren National Park on two wheels! We recommend spending three hours at a moderate pace for this adventure. Marvel at the picturesque views of Galway Bay and the most extraordinary landscape in Ireland. Roam the vast limestone ridges that the Burren is famous for, and keep your eyes peeled for the flora and fauna unique to this ecosystem.

After lunch, it is time to bid a fond farewell to the West and make your journey back to Dublin. If you have a little time left in Ireland <u>we can link</u> <u>you up with our other self-drive tours of Ireland</u> or arm you with fantastic things to do and see in Dublin before you finish your trip of a lifetime to the Emerald Isle.
